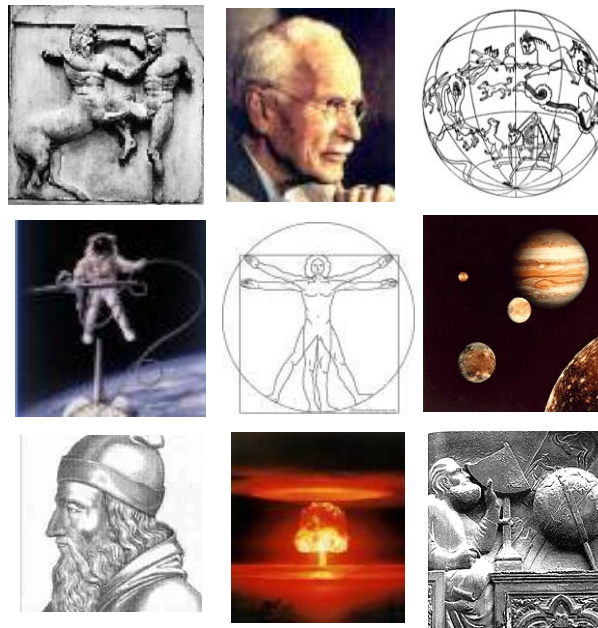

Joy received her AGE Honours Diploma in 2003 for her paper on the Arabic Parts.

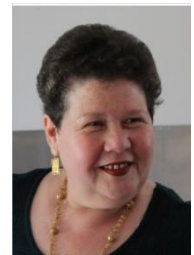

She has lectured at various astrological conferences around Australia including the Federation of Australian Astrologers Conference in 2010, the Regulus Traditional Astrology Conference, 2009 & 2010 as well as at the Astrological Association Conference in York, England in 2003.

Joy is co-author of *Scala Coeli: the Ladder of Heaven* published in 2012. She has been published in *The FAA Journal* and the *Australis '97 Congress Papers*, and, in 1999 and 2000 she was a regular columnist for *The Astrological Monthly Review*, a national magazine on astrology.

MARI GARCIA

Is a consulting astrologer who received the FAA Practitioners Certificate in 1995 and was awarded the Alan Johnson Gold Medal for achieving the highest marks in that year. Mari has also completed the Robert Zoller Medieval Astrology Course, and gained the Astro Logos Certificate in Medieval Astrology, the Medieval Post Graduate course and Accreditation in the Fixed Star Course.

ASTROLOGICAL EDUCATION

Studying Astrology

Astrology is an ancient art dating as far back as Babylonian times. Common perception considers astrology to be magical, religious, secret, supernatural or mystical. However, it is a combination of philosophy and science, with definite rules and specific techniques. Astrology is also an art where awareness, common sense and personal skills play an important role.

The study of astrology on a serious level requires time and commitment. It requires self-discipline and application. In other words, the study of astrology is an experience in hard work and objectivity rather than psychic ability. Astrology's primary tenet is that the individual is an integral part of the ebb and flow of the universe. Understanding this ebb and flow as it is reflected in the cycles and patterns of the heavens gives an insight into a person's life and the uniqueness of the individual. At the same time, it provides a canvas upon which the story of humanity is etched.

The fraternity of astrologers spans many centuries and continues to reach down through the ages. Every generation of astrologers has left their legacy on a body of knowledge which continues to grow as humanity evolves. As a student of astrology, you will be joining the ranks of many famous people who studied this ancient discipline, such as Aristotle, Thomas Aquinas, Nicolas Copernicus, Johannes Kepler, Michelle Gauquelin and Carl Jung, to name a few.

Frequently Asked Questions

I KNOW NOTHING ABOUT ASTROLOGY. DOES IT MATTER?

No. Astrology 101 starts at the beginning and gradually builds a foundation of astrological knowledge. The only prerequisite is that the student is twenty one years or older.

WHAT CAN I EXPECT TO LEARN DURING THE COURSE?

The Certificate course is designed to provide the student with the techniques and skills to calculate a natal chart, do simple delineation and predictive work. The level of individual effort will also affect the learning experience.

HOW MUCH WORK WILL I NEED TO DO?

Each Unit has 3 assignments and a Unit Assessment. The assignments have a set due date with some flexibility. To consolidate information discussed in class, a student can expect to spend up to two hours per week, reading and updating notes and preparing assignments.

HOW DO I KNOW I AM PROGRESSING?

A marking scale is used to evaluate students' work. The marking scale is a guide for both the student and the tutor as it indicates if the student has understood the astrological principles and their application. Comments and suggestions provide additional feedback.

DO I HAVE TO PASS EACH UNIT TO GO ON TO THE NEXT ONE?

Students are required to successfully complete each Unit and this means obtaining a final pass mark. The final mark is a combination of the marks of each assignment and the Unit assessment.



Previous Learning

CERTIFICATE COURSE

If you have studied astrology previously and wish to continue your studies at a level other than the beginning of the Certificate Course, then we ask that you to undertake our internal Unit assessment. This is the assessment given to enrolled Certificate students at the end of each Unit. You will be asked to complete the Unit Assessment previous to the Unit you wish to enrol in.

For example, if you wish to enrol in Astrology 201 we would ask you to complete the Unit Assessment for Astrology 102. A small fee of \$25.00 is charged and the assessment completed and marked before enrolment can take effect. The Assessment provides you with feedback on your level of competency to undertake the Unit. Should you be unsuccessful, we would suggest alternatives such as enrolling in a previous Unit, personal tutoring or undertaking the course from the beginning. If you successfully complete the Assessment, the assessment fee is deducted upon enrolment.

The Certificate Course consists of:

- ❖ Astrology 101 – *the first six months of the first year. Commences in February each year.*
- ❖ Astrology 102 – *the second six months of the first year. Commences in July each year.*
- ❖ Astrology 201 – *the first six months of the second year. Commences in February each year.*
- ❖ Astrology 202 – *the second six months of the second year. Commences in July each year.*

Unit content for the Certificate Course is outlined in this Guide.

DIPLOMA COURSE

All students wishing to enrol in the Diploma Course must have completed a minimum of two years study, or passed a recognised astrological exam. To discuss this, please consult us. The Diploma Course consists of:

UNIT 1 DELINEATION

Comprising twelve lectures, this Unit focuses on broadening and deepening delineation skills. Each of the twelve lectures emphasises the basic astrological principles, techniques and their application.

Prerequisite *Prospective students must have a minimum of two years study and be familiar with the basics of astrology.*

UNIT 2 PREDICTIVE TECHNIQUES

Comprising twelve lectures, this Unit will build on basic predictive skills and introduce a variety of other predictive techniques. The aim is to develop predictive packages which work.

Prerequisite *Prospective students must have a minimum of two years study and have an understanding and knowledge of simple predictive work is necessary.*

UNIT 3 RELATIONSHIPS

Comprising twelve lectures, this Unit emphasises the individual and the various types of relationships encountered in life.

Prerequisite *Prospective students must have a minimum of two years study and be familiar with the basics of astrology.*

Unit content for the Diploma Course is outlined in this Guide.



ASTROLOGICAL QUALIFICATIONS

As with any profession, the question of qualifications and their quality is always an important point for consideration. Qualifications ensure that the consultant astrologer is trained in a variety of techniques. This differentiates them from the interested amateur who has basic information gleaned from books and intermittent attendance at short courses or workshops.

The principals of Astro Mundi have developed a syllabus for both Certificate and Diploma levels.

The first step in gaining a professional astrological qualification involves successfully undertaking the Astro Mundi Certificate of Astrology exam. The sitting of the Diploma in Astrology after a further two years of study completes the process of gaining professional astrological qualifications.



THE CERTIFICATE COURSE

The Astro Mundi Certificate Course has been designed for the student who has little or no knowledge of astrology. The course provides the basic foundations of astrological techniques, structure and interpretation. Each Unit is conducted over six months and the Course is conducted over a two-year period.

The Certificate Course gives the student the skills to:

- ❑ Understand the basic astronomy of the celestial sphere
- ❑ Accurately calculate a horoscope with planets and luminaries to the nearest minute
- ❑ Understand the role of mythology in the development of the individual psyche
- ❑ Interpret planetary combinations
- ❑ Recognise and interpret major life cycles
- ❑ Identify and interpret future trends using a variety of predictive techniques.

Work Load

The Astro Mundi Certificate Course has a set amount of course work which students are expected to complete. The course work may consist of exercises in calculations or essay writing. The main objective of these assignments and exercises is to help the student to apply the techniques and principles which have been covered in class.

Each Unit has 3 assignments and a Unit Assessment. The assignments have a set due date with some flexibility. It is essential the student successfully completes the Unit Assessment before undertaking the following Unit.

Students are encouraged to consolidate information discussed in class through reading and updating notes and preparing assignments.



The First Year of the Certificate Course begins with....

ASTROLOGY 101

February - June

This is the foundation unit of the Certificate Course. All students must complete this Unit.

PRE-REQUISITE

Anyone over the age of 21 years can enrol in the Certificate Course.

OUTCOMES

By the end of the Unit the student will be able to:

1. Calculate the Ascendant, angles and house cusps for any given set of birth data.
2. Identify signs by element and modality.
3. Delineate the Cross of Matter and the twelve houses including the Ascendant and the MC.
4. Delineate the Sun by sign, house placement and rulership. Relate the relevant myth to the interpretation.
5. Understand the basis of essential dignities.



ASTROLOGY 102

July - November

This is the second unit of the Certificate Course.

The student takes the next step in astrological education. This Unit covers the astronomy of the planets as well as detailed exploration of astrological planetary meaning through the particular foci of planetary placement, zodiacal sign and house rulership

PREREQUISITE

Successful completion of Astrology 101 Assessment.

UNIT CONTENT

- ❑ Calculation of the planets
- ❑ Astrological meaning of the luminaries and the planets
- ❑ Application of Essential Dignities
- ❑ The laws and application of Planetary Rulership
- ❑ Aspect Theory

- ❑ The Relationship between the Luminaries: the Lutation Cycle
- ❑ Inner Planetary Combinations: the personal perspective
- ❑ The Social and the Personal: Jupiter and Saturn aspects to the inner planets.

- ❑ The Individual and the Collective: Uranus and Neptune aspects to the inner planets.
- ❑ Crisis, Conflict & Chaos: Pluto aspects to the inner planets.
- ❑ Jupiter and Saturn Cycles
- ❑ Mid-Life Crises: an astrological perspective
- ❑ Synodic Cycles of the Outer Planets

OUTCOMES

By the end of the Unit the student will be able to:

1. Calculate the exact position of the planets and luminaries in a natal chart.
2. Generate an astrological chart complete with planetary placements and aspects.
3. Apply the principles of astrological interpretation to simple planetary combinations including house rulership.
4. Understand the expression of the individual planets in their own charts and those of family and friends.
5. Implement and understand the impact of planetary cycles.



The Second Year of the Certificate Course starts with.....

ASTROLOGY 201

February - June

This is the third unit of the Certificate Course.

The student continues from the study of the static chart to incorporate the philosophy and principles of predictive astrology. This Unit also covers delineation of complex planetary combinations. This gives the student the opportunity to deepen their knowledge of the principles covered in previous Units.

PREREQUISITE

Successful completion of Astrology 102 Assessment.

- ❑ Major Life Cycles: the astrological stages of development

- ❑ The Vertex: calculation and interpretation
- ❑ The Arabic Parts

OUTCOMES

By the end of the Unit the student will be able to:

1. Recognise and appreciate the possible expression of complex chart and aspect patterns as well as unaspected planets.
2. Calculate and aspect transiting planets to the natal chart.
3. Draw up a Time Map and determine the order and significance of current transits to a chart.
4. Confidently judge the importance and the impact of transits to the person's life.
5. Interpret non-planetary facets of the chart.



ASTROLOGY 202

July - November

This is the fourth unit of the Certificate Course.

The student adds to their predictive skills by combining transits, secondary progression and eclipses in order to form an overview for a given period of time.

At the completion of this Unit, the student is capable of undertaking the Astro Mundi Certificate of Astrology examination.

PREREQUISITE

Successful completion of Astrology 201 Assessment.

UNIT CONTENT

- ❑ Secondary progressions: the principles and the difference between chart related and non-chart related progressions.
- ❑ Using an Ephemeris to find Secondary Progressions.
- ❑ Calculation of ACD and SPD.
- ❑ Use of secondary progressions in predictive astrology
- ❑ Progressed Lunation Cycle: a major non-chart related secondary progression

- ❑ Time Maps: constructing and interpreting them
- ❑ Eclipses and Saros Cycle
- ❑ Solar Arc: an alternative predictive technique
- ❑ Declination: astronomical aspecting
- ❑ Chart Mechanics: moving the chart through the celestial sphere
- ❑ Basic Delineation Skills

OUTCOMES

By the end of the Unit the student will be able to:

1. Calculate Secondary Progressions through the tools of Adjusted Calculated Date and Secondary Progressed Date.
2. Use an ephemeris to map the age and year of significant secondary progressions.
3. Draw up a Time Map combining transits and secondary progressions.
4. Determine the order and significance of the interplay between various predictive methods.
5. Combine the ability to simply interpret a natal chart with the skill to judge significant future trends.



THE DIPLOMA COURSE

The Astro Mundi Diploma Course consists of six units of study conducted over a two-year period. Units are conducted in any one of three teaching terms during the year and will rotate over a two-year period.

The teaching terms are as follows:

- ❑ February – May
- ❑ May – August
- ❑ August -October

Each Unit consists of 12 lectures and includes a number of workshops of the student's choice.

Any Diploma Unit is available for independent study to the student who does not wish to pursue the entire Diploma Course. Please note that Pre-requisites still apply.

PRE-REQUISITE

Any student wishing to enrol in any of the Diploma Course Units must hold a suitable astrological qualification. If a student is unsure of the level required to undertake the Diploma, please consult Astro Mundi before sending any money.

A Diploma Enrolment form must be completed and forwarded together with the appropriate fee before an enrolment is valid.

Astro Mundi reserves the right to decline an enrolment should the intending student fail to meet the enrolment criteria.

WORK LOAD

Each Unit has a non-compulsory assignment and these are designed to assess the student's understanding of the material covered in the Unit.

Diploma students are also expected to expand on the course material provided by reading recommended texts and by actively participating in class discussions and presentations.

Astro Mundi also encourages students to attend lectures, workshops and seminars conducted by astrological associations.



DIPLOMA UNIT 1: DELINEATION

This Unit expands on the basic delineation techniques covered in the Certificate Course.

A sound understanding and knowledge of simple aspect delineation is necessary. This Unit will build on basic delineation skills and introduce the concept of whole chart delineation.

UNIT PRE-REQUISITE

Any equivalent qualification covering two years study with a qualifying exam.

THE TRADITIONAL ASTROLOGY COURSE

Astro Mundi offers this course to further expand the knowledge and appreciation of astrological heritage which forms the basis of the profession. The course is ideal for those who want to explore traditional and medieval astrological techniques.

The course has been restructured and now consists of 4 semesters, each consisting of 13 lectures, giving the student a sound basis of the principles and techniques as well as their application. Weekly lectures are held on a Wednesday evening from 5:30 – 8:00 pm and students may attend in person or on-line. For details contact us on 1800 003 517.

Those wishing to enrol for the course must have a solid grounding in astrology as it will be assumed that the student is conversant with basic astrological techniques and principles. Two years of astrological study is recommended before attempting the Traditional Astrology course.

WORKLOAD

The Traditional Astrology course has an extensive reading list and students will be expected to read the recommended texts as well as supplement the course material with some set pieces of work.

COURSE CONTENT

The basis of the course is the body of Greek, Latin, Arabic and Jewish astrological works which are available in translation. Additional material has also been sourced from modern works. Where possible the student will be directed to the primary sources.

THE UNITS

The course is structured over two years and comprises four semesters of study. Each semester has 13 lectures and all follow a collective theme:

- ❑ Unit 1 : Covers the basic principles of Greek philosophy and how it underpins astrological techniques, principles and applications.
- ❑ Unit 2: Discusses and explores planetary meaning and relationships as well as house meanings and rulership.
- ❑ Unit 3: Examines the indicators of the people, the material and the social factors of a life.
- ❑ Unit 4: Examines temporal and spiritual matters, and favourable and unfavourable times.

- ❑ Substance and Satisfaction: the indicators which describe the ability of the native to generate wealth and to enjoy substance and pleasure in life.
- ❑ Illness, Disease and Misfortune: the indicators which describe physical and other tendencies or enemies which undermine the individual.
- ❑ Taking Care of Business: A sense of well-being and how to determine the nature, quality and capacity of the individual to look after themselves in all respects.
- ❑ The Moon's Noddings: some seem so blessed and others so cursed -- not all, but many are. The nature of benedictions or curses which the person must live with are explored.
- ❑ "Fiat Lux" –'Let there be Light': An introduction to the celestial philosophy of astrology and its reflection of the Divine.
- ❑ Lots of the Ascendant: Pars Futurorum & Pars Fortuna: "the Pars Futurorum signifies the soul and the body after the Pars Fortunae and the quality of these, and faith, prophecy, religion, and the culture of God." [G Bonatti]
- ❑ Religion, Faith & Spirituality: Deus: the techniques to examine the native's capacity to have a spiritual life and to achieve happiness.
- ❑ Hyleg & Alcocoden: The planet which gives life and that which determines its length is still applicable today -- knowing what the physical challenges are and when in life vitality is compromised.
- ❑ Profecions and Returns: predictive methods which determine the nature and subject matter of a time period and the manner of their unfoldment.
- ❑ Firdaria : looking at a planet's dominion of a certain period and how it determines the quality of that time in the person's life.
- ❑ Zodiacal releasing: a technique to find the important times in an individual's life for matters regarding fortune and spirit.
- ❑ Directions: planets and angles carried by primary direction motion are brought into successive aspects with each other as well as with angles and points giving a method of timing of life events.

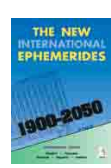
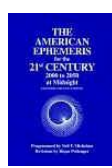
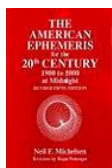
Distance Education Students

Distance Education enrolments are available throughout the year for all Astro Mundi courses. Please phone the toll free number 1800 003 517 or email astromundi@internode.on.net to discuss the best available option and before sending any money.

Materials & Texts

All enrolled students receive a Student Kit, which provides a recommended reading list of astrological texts for the particular Unit.

Astro Mundi publishes *The Astrology Primer* which synthesises the combined knowledge and experience of its principals and is only available to enrolled students. *The Astrology Primer* is the Certificate Course study manual and consists of three volumes used extensively throughout the course. Certificate students will need to purchase the appropriate volume of *The Astrology Primer* for their Unit as this cost is not included in the tuition fee.



Astrology 101 students will need an **Ephemeris**. Several editions are available: The American Ephemeris comes in 2 volumes – 20th & 21st century and covers the years 1900 – 2050. The International Ephemeris also covers the same time span but is more compact in one volume. Both are **Midnight ephemerides**.

A Table of Houses is also required and the recommended one is *The Michelsen Book of Tables*. The most important thing is to ensure that the Tables are for the **Placidus House system**. Both books will be needed by the second lecture. A student may already have these texts, if so, it is recommended they bring these to the tutors' attention to ascertain if they are compatible with the recommended texts.



Astrology 102 students will need a **scientific calculator** and *The Book of Notable Births*, a compendium of famous people's charts and biographies, published and only available from Astro Mundi.

Students enrolled in the Diploma and Traditional Astrology courses are provided with notes and handouts for topics covered in as well as extensive reading lists.



FEES

Course fees cover lecture time, handouts, marking and feedback on assignments. These fees are itemised on all enrolment forms. Payments can be made in cash, cheque, money order, credit card or electronic funds transfer. Please make all cheques and money orders payable to *Astro Mundi*. Credit cards accepted include VISA and Mastercard. Payments can also be made by Paypal. If you do not have a Paypal account, you can advise that you wish to pay in this manner and we will send you a secure link so that you can use your credit card safely on-line. Please note that sending any card details by email is risky. Contact us first before you do.

Attending Students

Enrolment fees can be paid in two ways:

- *Full fee payment* – Fees paid in full either in advance or at commencement of Lecture One.
- *Part fee payment* – Fees can be paid in 3 instalments: the first instalment is payable on enrolment, second and third payments are due on Lecture Two and Lecture Six of the course respectively.

Please note: in order to secure a place in the Course, no enrolments can be accepted unless accompanied by payment of a deposit as stipulated on the enrolment form.

Distance Education Students

Enrolment fees can be paid in two ways:

- *Full fee payment* – Fees paid receive the complete set of materials and Downloads or CD's. These are sent by post and email on receipt of the full payment. If the Unit is being currently conducted, the student will receive an initial package of Course materials and then all other handouts are sent electronically as PDF files.
- *Part fee payment* – Fees can be paid in three instalments: please consult the current enrolment form available on-line or by emailing astromundi@internode.on.net. The Distance Education student receives the first set of materials and CD's or Downloads. Subsequent sets are sent as each instalment is paid.

No assignments or assessments can be marked or returned if monies are outstanding.

Refunds & Deferrals

The student must notify Astro Mundi no later than the third lecture of the Unit. A Student who has **paid their fees in full may defer a percentage of fees** towards the next intake of an Astro Mundi course. The student must notify Astro Mundi no later than the third lecture of the Unit. A Student who has **paid part of their fees and elects to leave** the course is not entitled to a refund.
